

BUYER'S INFORMATION

JS Fine Art is based just outside Banbury in Oxfordshire, on the A4260 towards Oxford. Our large auction rooms have plenty of free on-site parking, and are within easy reach of the M40 and A34.

Our auction catalogues are both printed and also illustrated on our website and <u>www.the-saleroom.com</u> We can also email you catalogues or notify you that the catalogue has gone online.

Viewing times: the auctions are on view on the day before the auction from 9am-7pm and on the morning of the auction from 8.30am until 10am when the auction starts.

We email condition reports and images, at your request, although we regret that we are unable to do this on sale day.

We accept commission bids via email or phone and will bid up to that amount on your behalf. We start all commission bids as low as the reserve and/or other bids will allow. We also undertake telephone bids at our discretion. All bids should be with us by 5pm on the day before the auction as we regret that we are unable to accept any bids on sale day.

TELEPHONE BIDDING

All requests for telephone bids must be in by 5pm on the day before the auction.

Due to the large number of requests for telephone bids that we receive, we regret that we are unable to accept telephone bids unless,

- a) you are prepared to bid up to at least the top estimate should the bidding go that far, and
- b) you are prepared to open bidding at a minimum of £300 regardless of any estimate

COMMISSION BIDDING

Due to the large number of requests for commission bids that we receive, we must ask that all commission bids are received by 5pm on the day before the auction. Please note that we cannot guarantee to execute any bids received after this time.

POST SALE - POSTAGE & PACKING

Please ensure you read all of the information and pricing listed below prior to buying your lots. (if you have further questions, please email us enquiries@jsfineart.co.uk)

We understand that it's not always possible to be at the sale or collect your purchased lots.

We do offer an in-house domestic UK only postal and packing service however please understand that this service is strictly only available during the seven days following an auction.

Nb. we no longer post any parcels internationally as tracking services in other countries are very limited - we apologise for this inconvenience.

Our in-house domestic service is not cheap — we offer this service as courtesy but we do charge a premium - Please be aware these prices are minimum charges — more complicated and fragile lots will attract a premium for packing. (Please remember we are NOT eBay or Amazon- we are an independent auctioneer.)

We reserve the right to refuse to pack and send any parcel that we feel is not suitable to be shipped.

Our minimum charge for any small package sent within the UK is £20 plus vat sent via Royal Mail Special Delivery (This will include post office insurance if your item being posted is within their terms and condition and not prohibited).

Our minimum charge for packing any lot ready for collection is £10 plus vat - if a parcel courier is collecting your lot you must ensure that any appropriate labels are forwarded to us in plenty of time prior to collection and that you send a confirmation email naming the courier you nominate for collection. The courier must have a confirmed copy of a receipted invoice.

Larger parcels can be sent via Parcelforce 48 — our minimum charge for packing and shipping within the UK mainland is £35 plus vat- highlands and islands may cost more as will excessively large parcels -we will advise on suitability for shipping as requested.

Glazed pictures over 30 cm cannot be shipped by ourselves – no claims can be made for damage in transit of glass and likewise we cannot insure fragile frames.



WE WILL NOT SHIP any firearms or ammunition, deactivated guns, section 58 obsolete & antique guns, airguns, swords of any type, bottled wines or spirits, fuels and oils of any type. (Other exclusions may apply please contact us if in any doubt.)

TRANSPORT & DIRECTIONS

We must express that we are not professional packers or shippers but are now very experienced. We will do our best to ensure that your parcel is packed in a way to ensure the item is safe for its journey. Please contact us so we can advise if the lot is suitable for sending on. If we cannot post the lot to you due to size or weight, you are welcome to arrange collection by another carrier. A list of our recommended carriers is detailed at the bottom of this page. If you were bidding via online bidding portals and/ or are paying by Debit card, due to increased security measures, we will only despatch parcels to the registered cardholder's address. Any requests for parcels to be sent to an alternative address are at the discretion of the auctioneer - WE ADVISE PAYMENT TO US BY BACS WIRE TRANSFER TO OUR BANK.

We remind customers that many antiques CANNOT BE INSURED due to the nature and sometimes fragility of such lots and the carriers' terms and conditions. Items are normally sent within seven working days of payment but we are unable to guarantee delivery times.
